

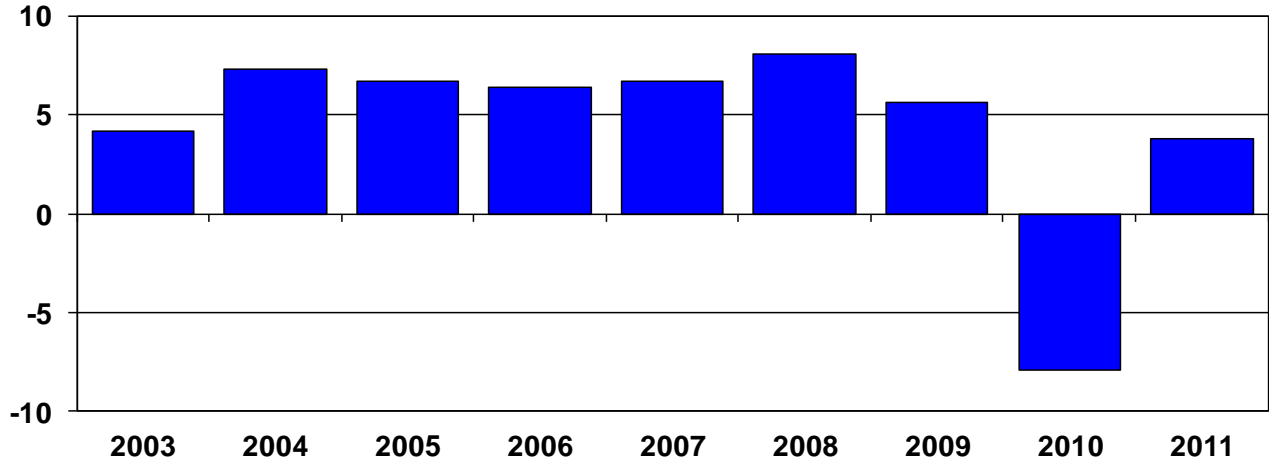
Russia GDP growth

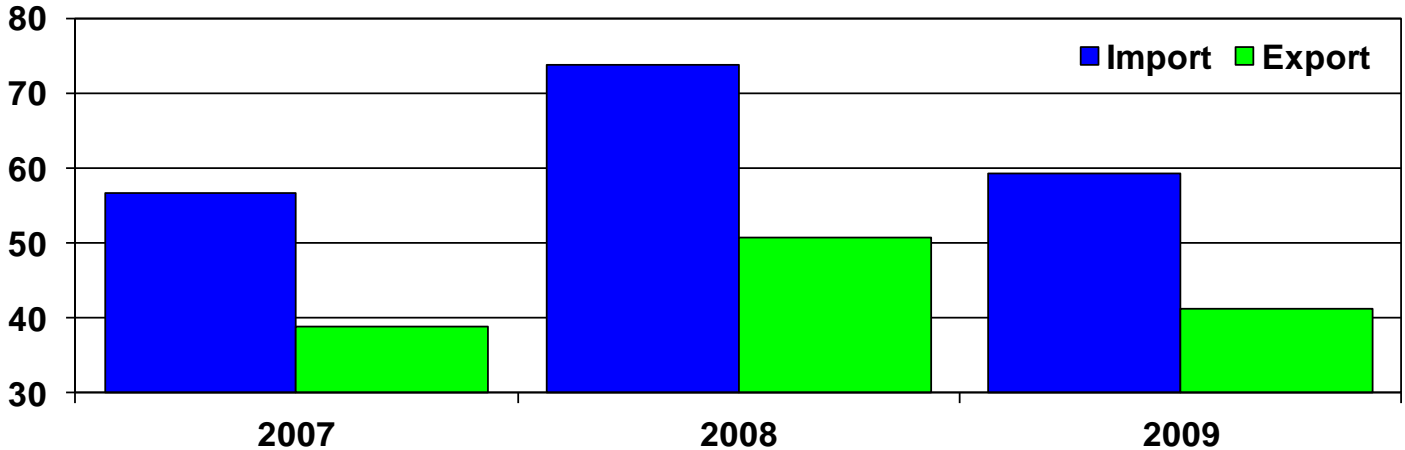
Russian international trade in services

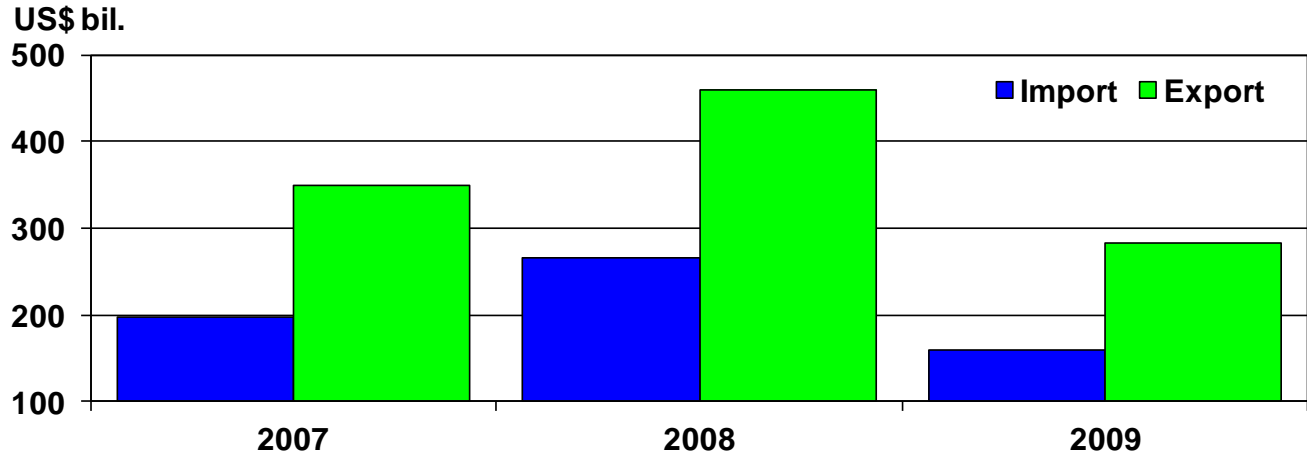

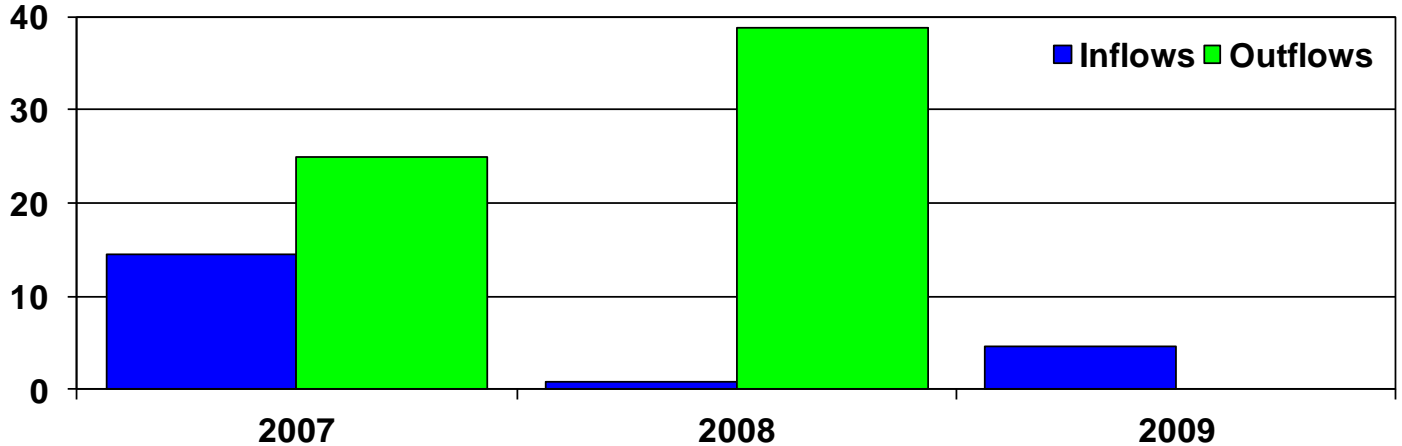
Russian FDI flows with EU27

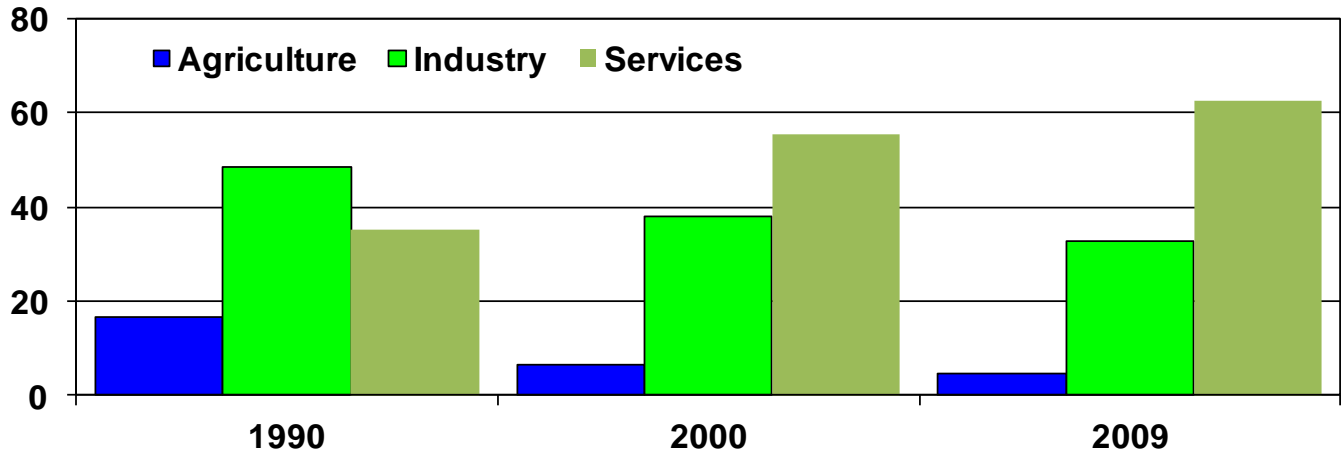
Russia GDP by sector

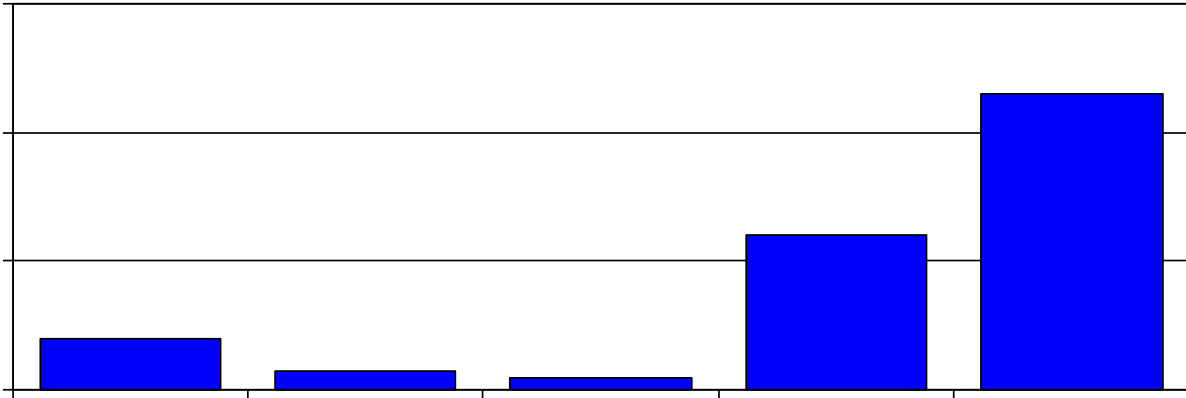

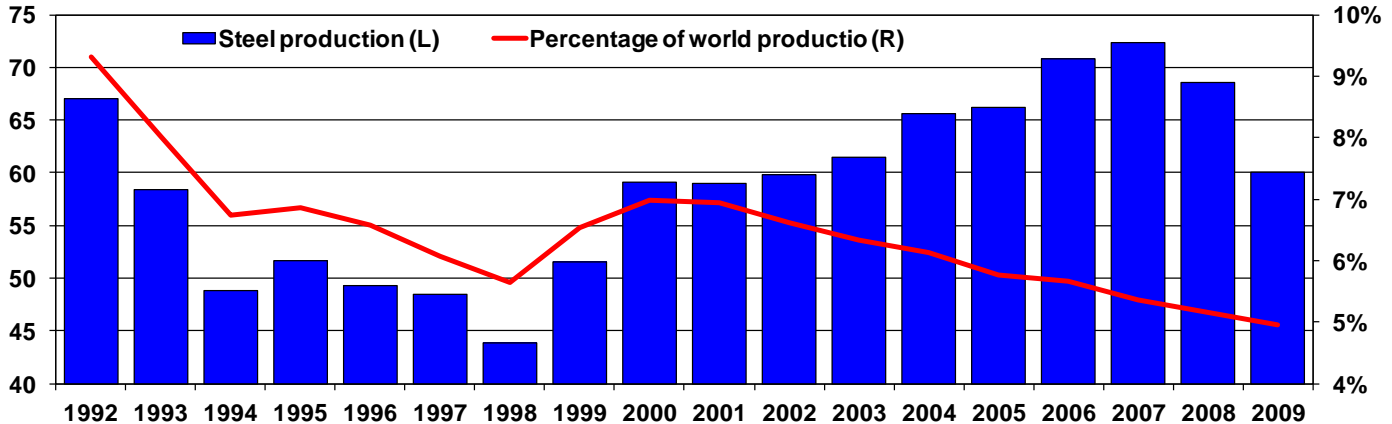
Steel production in Russia

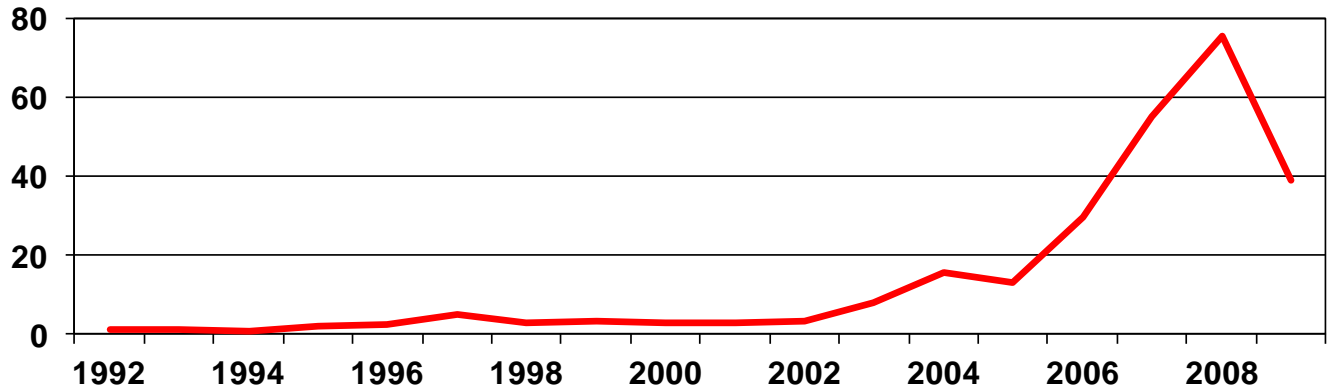
Inward foreign direct investments in Russia
